You'll probably be eligible for a free upgrade through your existing license agreements with Microsoft, so it shouldn't cost you any extra.

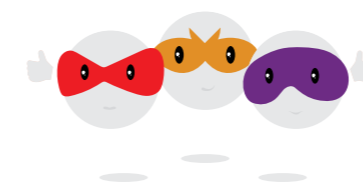
If there are any problems they'll sort them out for you. Like we said, we're the sidekick. You wear the cape and tights while we operate strictly in the background.

And as students can **find homework instantly** online you can save on print. This may seem like a small thing to begin with but over time the saving can easily run into the thousands.

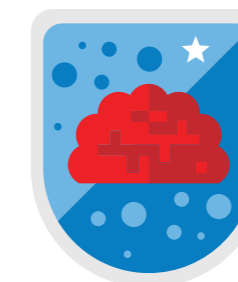
Just think what you could do with the money. More books, more equipment, educational trips. It could make a **big difference**.
